PUBLIC SAFETY AND FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 7/15/98

Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 4-0-1, (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Bailey, Scott and Wilson. Abstained: Hendershot).

This Resolution will approve the Charter of the Redevelopment Authority as required under CB-85-1997. The names of the initial members of the Redevelopment Authority will be inserted after the Council's review and confirmation. (pp 3)

The County Executive noted that the provisions of the Charter are somewhat generic in nature because the specific procedures for the Redevelopment Authority will be contained in the regulations that will be submitted to the Council for approval once the Redevelopment Authority is established. The legislation was amended to establish a deadline for the submission of operation regulations to the Council, to list the amount of compensations for the members and require the General Counsel to maintain a close liaison with the County Attorney.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-60-1998.
