## TRANSPORTATION, HOUSING AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE DATE: 5/3/01

Committee Vote: Favorable with amendment, 3-0, (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Hendershot and Shapiro)

Staff explained the purpose of CR-10-2001 and informed the Committee of referral comments that were received at the public hearing held on April 30, 2001. The Director of the Department of Housing and Community Development described the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) proposal submittal process that started on September 7, 2000 with a forum and workshop. He further explained that the Proposal Advisory Group (PAG), met on March 1, 2001 to review the proposals and ranked them high, medium, low or no priority according to the criteria established in the five-year Consolidated Plan. The Director indicated that for Program Year 27, Seventy-five project proposals totaling nearly \$12 million were received against the \$7,470,000 available.

The Director of DHCD further explained the funding for the annual Federal entitlements under the CDBG, HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) and Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) programs. It was indicated that the funding for the ESG programs was the same as last year.

Staff explained that fifty-three proposals are recommended for funding in the categories of Acquisition and Rehabilitation, Economic Development, Public Facilities, Public Services, Relocation, and Planning and Administration.

The Transportation, Housing and Environment Committee reviewed the Annual Action Plan, focusing on each of the above-mentioned categories. A technical amendment was made on page 3, Attachment A, under Public Facilities Projects, City of District Heights project should be listed in Councilmanic District 6 and not 7.

Office of Law find CR-10 to be in proper legislative form and the Office of Audits and Investigations determines that there should be no negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-10-2001.
