Dear Chairman Hawkins:

Enclosed for the County Council's consideration and approval is a Bill that includes parking restrictions on commercial buses, trailers, and trucks accompanied by a schedule of fines. Under the International Property Maintenance Code, administrative citations may be issued for violations under the Housing Code. It stipulates civil fines for parking in violation of the zoning ordinance. It establishes parking restrictions regarding habitation in vehicles parking in the public right-of-way to include fines. This Bill authorizes immobilization and impoundments without prior notice to owners of vehicles with five (5) or more unpaid traffic and/or parking violations. The Residential Parking Program petition process rolls back the consensus requirement from sixty (60%) percent to fifty-one (51%) percent and stipulates the cost for Residential Parking Permits.
