The contract is a multi-year agreement in the not-to-exceed amount of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00). The contract provides professional support services to assist County staff, the Climate Action Implementation Task Force and the Resident Advisory Group for Climate Action and Environmental Justice with developing the County’s Climate Action Plan Implementation Strategy in accordance with Executive Order No. 5 - 2022 and Council Resolution CR-32-2022.
