AN ACT CONCERNING INTERPROJECT TRANSFERS OF APPROPRIATIONS IN THE APPROVED FISCAL YEAR 2024 CAPITAL BUDGET AND SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATIONS IN THE APPROVED FISCAL YEAR 2024 CAPITAL BUDGET for the purpose of transferring appropriations to the Surratts-Clinton Branch Renovation (4.71.0005), Baden Public Library (4.71.0007), and New Glenridge Area Middle School #2 (3.77.0016) projects and providing supplementary appropriations to the Clean Water Partnership NPDES/MS4 (5.54.0018), MS4/NPDES Compliance & Restoration (5.54.0019), Street Lights & Traffic Signals 2 (1.66.0001), Bus Mass Transit/Metro Access 2 (4.66.0006), Green Street Improvements (4.66.0008), Maryland Purple Line (7.66.0001), Addison Road/Capitol Heights Metro Corridor (8.90.0002), County Revitalization (8.90.0004), and Cheverly Development (9.90.0001) projects.

Legislative Summary

CB-048-2024, presented by Chair Ivey at the request of the County Executive, was presented on May 28, 2024, and referred to the Committee of the Whole. CB-048-2024 authorizes the interproject transfer of capital funding and supplemental funding for additional capital projects by amending the Fiscal Year 2024 Approved Capital Budget as established in CB-063-2023¹.

Current Law/Background

Section 814² of the County Charter authorizes interproject transfers of appropriations between capital projects approved by the Council at the request of the County Executive but maintains that no new project shall be created nor abandoned. Section 815³ of the County Charter allows the Council, upon the recommendation of the County executive, by legislative act, to make additional or supplemental appropriations from revenue received from anticipated and unanticipated sources sources.

Discussion/Policy Analysis

CB-048-2024 authorizes the interproject transfer of funds between capital projects as well as supplemental funding for capital projects. In total, \$12,582,000 is being transferred from five (5) different capital projects in the FY 2024 Approved Capital Budget to three (3) other projects in the

budget. Supplemental appropriations totaling \$5,669,700 are being used to provide additional funding to capital projects. Revenue for the supplemental appropriations comes from both State and federal sources.

Fiscal Impact

• Direct Impact:

CB-048-2024 is not expected to have an adverse fiscal impact on the County budget. The bill increases total expenditures in the FY 2024 Capital Budget by \$5,669,700 through the use of supplemental funding, but these funds are from State and federal sources rather than general County funds. The bill also shifts \$12,582,000 in capital project funding to different projects.
