BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Redevelopment Authority

3 For the purpose of revising the composition of the membership of the Redevelopment Authority.

4 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

5 SUBTITLE 15B. REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

6 Section 15B-118,

7 The Prince George's County Code

8 (1999 Edition, 2002 Supplement).

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
 10 Maryland, that Section 15B-118 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
 11 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

12 **SUBTITLE 15B. REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.**

13 **DIVISION 2. REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY ESTABLISHED.**

14 **Sec. 15B-118. Membership.**

15 (a) The Redevelopment Authority shall consist of [five (5)] seven public members and two
 16 [(2)] ex officio members. Three of the [five (5)] seven public members shall be residents of the
 17 County. All shall be voting members. The ex officio members shall be the Chief Administrative
 18 Officer of the County or a Deputy Chief Administrative Officer, as designated by the County
 19 Executive, and the Director of Housing and Community Development of the County.

20 (b) All members shall be persons who possess ability, experience, and integrity.

1 (c) Five of the [The] public members shall be appointed by the County Executive for terms
2 of four [(4)] years each and confirmed by the County Council. Two of the public members shall
3 be appointed by the County Council according to the Council's rules. The terms of the
4 appointments shall be staggered in such a manner that the terms of office of no more than two
5 [(2)] members of the Redevelopment Authority may expire in the same year.

6 (d) Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term in the manner of original appointment.
7 Each member shall serve until a successor is appointed and qualified even though the period of
8 service may extend beyond the four [(4)] year term. All official acts and votes of any member
9 during the period of extended service shall be valid as if the member were within said four [(4)]
10 year term. A member of the Redevelopment Authority may be removed by the County
11 Executive for cause.

12 (e) Two of the public members shall be designated by the County Executive to serve as
13 Chairman and Vice Chairman. Each such officer shall serve until a successor is designated even
14 though the period of service may extend beyond the period originally designated by the County
15 Executive. All official acts of any such officer during the period of extended office shall be valid
16 as if the officer were within the period of original designation.

17 (f) The public members shall be entitled to such compensation as is established in the
18 annual operating budget of the Redevelopment Authority, provided that such compensation shall
19 be paid only for meetings actually attended.

1 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
2 calendar days after it becomes law.
