Committee Vote: Favorable; 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Russell, Estepp, Maloney and Scott).

Staff summarized the amendments proposed to the Town's Code concerning parking, residential driveways and related penalties.

The Planning Board staff reviewed the two ordinances that have been adopted by the Town of Landover Hills for compatibility with the County's Zoning Ordinance and found there are no inconsistencies. The Planning Board supports CR-5-2000.

The County Executive takes no position on CR-5-2000 and the Office of Audits and Investigations determined there should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting the resolution.

The Legislative Officer has determined that the resolution is in proper legislative form.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**

Article 28, Section 8-112.1 of the Annotated Code of Maryland requires that certain municipal ordinances regulating residential parking, fences, and outdoor storage be approved by the District Council before the ordinance becomes effective. The proposed resolution approves amendments to the Town of Landover Hills Code. The resolution will approve the enactment of Ordinance No. O-12 amending Sections 9802 and 9802.1 of the Code of the Town of Landover Hills concerning parking and Ordinance No. 99-O-13 amending Sections 7404 and 2802 concerning residential driveways and penalties
