The Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee convened on October 21, 2024, to consider **CR-092**-2024, the Creation of a **Regional Service Director PILOT Program** for Langley Park. The Regional Service Director would serve as the coordinator between the community, commercial interests, and the government, among others, to advocate, set a vision, and bring services to the Langley Park community.

The Resolution was presented to the County Council on October 1<sup>st</sup> and held in committee on October 7, as requested by the County Executive's office, to allow for more study and to work with the sponsor, Council member Fisher.

During the October 21, 2024, committee meeting, Council Member Fisher proposed an amendment on page l, line 14, adding the County Government to replace the Office of Community Relations.

Ms. Sakinda Skinner, representing the Office of the County Executive, expressed support for the legislation.

The Office of Law finds CR-92-2024 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

After discussion, The Prince George's County Council, Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee, reported CR-92-2024 out favorably, 4-0 as amended.
