12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
 13 Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional
 14 District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-132 of the Zoning Ordinance of
 15 Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code,
 16 be and the same is repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

Sec. 27-132. District Council hearing procedures.

(g) Judicial appeals.

In the event of judicial appeal, oral argument, including all deliberations before the District Council, shall be transcribed and made a part of the record. The record shall also include any findings of fact and conclusions of law adopted by dissenting Council Members. All costs of transcription shall be paid by the appellant.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after its adoption.
