For the purpose of establishing that the County Council of Prince George's County support and		
encourage the Nigerian and United States governments to commit any and all efforts to rescue		
the kidnapped gi	rls in Nigeria.	
WHEREAS, on April 14, 2014, approximately 276 girls were abducted from a school in		
Nigeria by mem	bers of Boko Haram, an Islamist militant group; and	
WHEREAS, Abubakar Shekau, leader of Boko Haram has vowed to sell them as slaves;		
and		
WHEREAS, these actions by Boko Haram constitute human trafficking and is		
unequivocally objected to by Prince George's County; and		
WHEREAS, the County is in support of efforts to rescue these girls by any means		
necessary; and		
WHEREAS	WHEREAS, the County's sentiment is consistent with the eradication of Human	
Trafficking as described in CR-74-2013, a Resolution creating the Human Trafficking Task		
Force.		
NOW, THI	EREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's	
County, Maryland, that the County encourages the Nigerian and United States governments to		
commit any and all efforts to rescue the kidnapped young women in Nigeria.		
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County supports any and all actions to eradicate		
human trafficking of children and adults around the world and in the United States.		

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County encourages people to utilize Twitter,

Instagram, Facebook and any other social media outlets to initiate a campaign aimed at putting pressure on the Nigerian government to accept assistance from the United States in rescuing the captives.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County denounces any group that seeks to deny girls and women the right to receive a formal education.
