

PROGRAM OVERVIEW



Funding and Regulatory Guidance: Treasury and state

Eligibility Criteria: Income equal to or less than 80% AMI, hardship due to or during COVID, renting unit

Prince George's County ERAP: Launched March 4, 2021; Closed December 15, 2021

Prioritization and Methodology: Landlord applications by census tracts of greatest vulnerability; Tenants in legal process for eviction; others by chronological order

Coordination and Support: Community partners assisted applications, OCR provides Help Desk, biweekly eviction prevention meetings support coordination to minimize evictions

Reporting and Monitoring: Weekly reporting to monitor progress, daily stand-up meetings to address issues, meetings with state provide regulatory guidance

ERAP RESOURCES

Original ERAP 1 & 2 Amounts:

\$ 93.7M for rental and utility assistance (Total including admin costs \$105M)


Additional ERAP 1&2 Allocations & Re-allocations:

\$ 25.8M for rental and utility assistance (Total including admin costs \$28.2M)

Grant total to date:

\$ 119.5M for rental and utility assistance

Total including admin costs \$133.5M




