BILL

AN ACT concerning

Department of Family Services

For the purpose of amending the provisions of the Code regarding staffing for the Commission for Women and the Commission for Individuals with Disabilities.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

Sections 2-137 and 2-438,

The Prince George's County Code

(1991 Edition, 1994 Supplement).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that Sections 2-137 and 2-438 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same are hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

DIVISION 6. COMMISSION FOR WOMEN.

Sec. 2-137. Administrative support.

(a) [There shall be an Executive Director of the Commission who shall be part of the administrative] Administrative support for the Commission shall be provided by the Department of Family Services.

Sec. 2-438. [Director; staff] Administrative support.

(a) [There shall be a Director of the Commission who shall be part of the

administrative] Administrative support for the Commission shall be provided by the Department of Family Services.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
