**BILL**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 An Interproject Transfer of Appropriations in the Approved Fiscal Year 2001 Capital Budget  
 3 For the purpose of transferring appropriations between capital projects in the amount of  
 4 \$3,000,000 from the Contingency Fund to the Resurfacing and Safety Improvements capital  
 5 project.

6 WHEREAS, the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland, provides for the adoption of  
 7 the County budget, which includes the capital budget and capital program; and

8 WHEREAS, pursuant to CB-33-2000, the County budget, known as the Annual Budget and  
 9 Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George's County for Fiscal Year 2000-2001, which includes  
 10 the Fiscal Year 2001-2006 Capital Improvement Program - Fiscal Year 2001 Capital Budget was  
 11 adopted; and

12 WHEREAS, the Approved Fiscal Year 2001-2006 Capital Improvement Program sets forth  
 13 the plan of the County to receive and expend funds for capital projects during the fiscal year  
 14 covered by the capital budget and the next succeeding five fiscal years thereafter and also the  
 15 means of financing said projects; and

16 WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 818 of the Charter for Prince George's  
 17 County, Maryland, the County Council may authorize, by legislative act, upon request of the  
 18 County Executive, interproject transfers of appropriations between capital projects in the  
 19 Approved Capital Budget; and

20 WHEREAS, the County Executive deems it desirable to provide additional appropriations  
 21 for the Resurfacing and Safety Improvements capital project as currently existing appropriations

1 are inadequate for project completion; and

2 WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends that appropriations can be transferred from  
3 the Contingency Fund, as an excess of appropriations over estimated costs in the budget year  
4 exists; now, therefore

5 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George’s County,  
6 Maryland, that the Fiscal Year 2001 Approved Capital Budget is hereby amended, as shown on  
7 Schedule A and Schedule B, attached hereto and made a part hereof, to provide that  
8 appropriations are transferred as follows:

22 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the Approved Fiscal Year 2001-2006  
23 Capital Improvement Program is hereby amended as shown on Schedule A and Schedule B  
24 attached hereto and made a part hereof, amending the total project cost, and expenditure and  
25 revenue schedules for the following projects:

31 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)  
32 calendar days after it becomes law, and be retroactively effective to June 30, 2001.
