CB-008-2019 Regular County Holidays - Native American Day

Legislative Summary


CB-008-2019 seeks to recognize the history, culture and accomplishments of Native Americans in Prince George's County and across the nation by renaming Columbus Day to Native American Day in Prince George's County.

Background

Section 16-219 of the Prince George's County Code defines the regular holidays for employees who are employed by Prince George's County. Currently, the holidays recognized are: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King's Birthday, Presidential Inauguration Day, Washington's Birthday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, County Employees' Appreciation Day, and Christmas Day.

Assumptions and Methodology

The proposed Resolution seeks to rename the County employee holiday of 'Columbus Day' to 'Native American Day'.



Fiscal Impact

Direct Impact

Enactment of CB-008-2019 may have a minimal adverse fiscal impact on the County related to the costs of various requests to reprint and reproduce County documents to accurately reflect the name change.

Enactment of CB-008-2019 should not have an adverse indirect impact on the County.
