Conversion of Hospital to Health Campus is subject to the requirements listed in Section 27-362(a)(2) and (3) of this Subtitle, except Sections 27-362(a)(2)(D) and (G) shall not apply. Not less than fifteen percent (15%) of the site shall be devoted to green area. Wherever a special exception is required within Section 27-362 instead, a detailed site plan shall be required and approved in accordance with Part 3 Division 9 of this Subtitle. The Health Campus may include a state licensed freestanding medical facility in addition to or in lieu of a general acute care hospital.
