Dear Chair Dernoga:

It is my pleasure to submit to you and the County Council the appointment of Mr. Daniel L. Schaible and the reappointment of Mr. Johnathan L. Bolden, Mr. Antwan D. Holbert, and Mr. Vanessa E. Surles to the Fire Commission for Prince George's County. The Fire Commission reviews the financial needs and requests for public funds of each of the County's volunteer fire companies. It formulates annually, one capital budget, one capital improvement program, and one current expense budget for all volunteer fire companies with respect to the expenditure of public funds, and shall submit said budgets and program, together with appropriate justification, to the County Executive in accordance with the provisions of the Charter.

Mr. Daniel "Danny" L. Schaible, a resident of Hyattsville, is a Project Specialist with the National Park Services (NPS) Denver Service Center. As a federal employee, he has had oversight over an array of transportation projects in the National Capital Region, including the rehabilitation of the Arlington Memorial Bridge, Beach Drive in Rock Creek Park, Historic Stone Bridge in Manassas, and the restoration of Iwo Jima Drive. In this position, he manages the development of construction documents, prepares Independent Government Cost estimates, and monitors projects for quality control during design and construction. Mr. Schaible received his Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Oregon and serve on the City of Hyattsville, City Council.


Mr. Johnathan L. Bolden, a resident of Upper Marlboro, is a Senior Project Manager with over two decades of experience providing chiller replacement services to large commercial, industrial, and governmental entities. He has served as Fire Service Instructor since 1996 and as a Senior Management Instructor since 2005 with the University of Maryland Fire and Rescue Institute. Mr. Bolden was appointed in 2021 as a volunteer member and currently serves as the chair.

Mr. Antwan D. Holbert, a resident of Upper Marlboro, has been a Fire Fighter/Medic with the Prince George's County for over fourteen (14) years. He is a three-time recipient of the Prince George's County Public Safety Valor Award for heroism. Mr. Holbert has trained and mentored firefighters here in the United States as well as those abroad. He will serve as a sworn member and was appointed in 2021.

Ms. Vanessa E. Surles, a resident of Capitol Heights, brings extensive accounting, finance and human resource management skills gained through the non-profit and private sectors. She has been a Volunteer Firefighter/EMT-B since 1992, responding to medical alerts in the community, performing complete medical and psychological assessments. Vice Chair Surles was appointed in 2021 and will serve as a volunteer member.
