BILL

AN ACT concerning

County Pension Plans

For the purpose of deleting from the plan documents of the several supplemental pension plans provisions relating to early retirement, enhanced benefits and the payment of accumulated sick leave for persons "involuntarily separated" from County employment.

WHEREAS, pursuant to various salary plans submitted by the County Executive and approved by the County Council, supplemental pension plans have been established for County employees; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the various supplemental pension plans have approved amendments to the plans that provide for the receipt of enhanced retirement benefits and the payment to certain covered employees for the cash value of accumulated sick leave in the event that such employees are "involuntarily separated;" and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to amend the provisions of the several supplemental pension plans to delete the "involuntary separation" enhanced benefits relating to increased benefit amounts, payment of benefits prior to attaining eligibility for normal retirement, and the payment of the value of 100% of the employee's accumulated sick leave balance; now, therefore.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that, notwithstanding the provisions of any pension plan or supplemental pension plan authorized pursuant to Section 16-230 of the Prince George's County Code or authorized

pursuant to any collective bargaining agreement or authorized pursuant to any salary plan

proposed by the County Executive and approved by the County Council, any provision

providing for "involuntary separation" enhanced benefits which increase benefit amounts,

provide for the payment of benefits prior to attaining eligibility for normal retirement, and

provide for the payment of the value of 100% of the employee's accumulated sick leave

balance shall be declared null and void.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that each of the several supplemental

pension plan documents shall be amended to reflect the deletion of "involuntary separation"

enhanced benefits as provided herein.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the Trustees of the several

supplemental pension plans shall report to the Council the appropriate action taken by the

Trustees to implement this Act.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)

calendar days after it becomes law.
