PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT

Date: 6/6/96

Committee Vote: Favorable, as amended, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Estepp, Bailey, Del Giudice, Maloney and Scott).

This resolution will establish a Task Force to examine the operation of the Board of Education and identify areas where efficiency and savings can be accomplished by consolidation of similar functions or responsibilities.

The Board of Education recommended that this new Task Force be used to update information on the

Consolidation Task Force of several years ago. Also, the Task Force membership should include an additional Board of Education and School System representation and representation from the school employee organization. The Superintendent supports this resolution with the above noted amendments.

Members of the Committee expressed a concern for student representation on the Task Force.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-27-1996.
