Dear Chair Oriadha:

Enclosed for the County Council's consideration are the proposed supplemental allocations to the approved FY 2026 Local Impact Grant (LIG) Funds Multi-Year Spending Plan in the amount of \$4,053,700.00.

Pursuant to Section 10-309.02(a) of the Prince George's County Code, and prior to submitting the Multi-Year Plan to the Local Development Council, the County Executive shall transmit the Multi-Year Plan to the County Council for review and comment. In accordance with County Law, the County Council has 30 days to review, comment, and make recommendations.

This supplemental reflects an update to the Fiscal Year 2026 spending plan and specifies the use of LIG funds consistent with State Government Article, Section 9-1A-31, which provides that such funds shall be used for improvements in communities in immediate proximity to video lottery facilities, including investments in public safety, economic and community development, and other essential public services.

The enclosed supplemental allocates \$4,053,700 in Community Impact Grant funding to:

- Victory Church International DBA Greater Works Ministries to support the Youth Jobs and Apprenticeship Program, Youth Leadership Academy, scholarships, and community-based programming serving District 8 residents.

This investment advances the County's continued commitment to youth development, workforce readiness, and community-based programming that delivers direct, measurable impact for residents. It builds upon previously approved FY 2026 investments and ensures that resources are deployed in a manner that is both responsive to community needs and aligned with the County's broader strategic priorities.

As with prior LIG plans, this supplemental bill reflects a people-centered approach to funding that prioritizes opportunity, public safety, and long-term community stability, while maintaining consistency with the Council-approved FY 2026 budget framework.
