RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Westphalia Sector Plan and Sectional Map Amendment

For the purpose of initiating an amendment to the 1994 Approved Master Plan for Melwood-Westphalia (Planning Areas 77 and 78) and the 2002 Prince George's County Approved General Plan that will establish goals, policies and strategies to guide orderly development of a planned community in the Westphalia area as described in the October 2005 Westphalia Comprehensive Concept Plan study. The goals of the sector plan are to recommend land use, zoning, and design guidelines that will establish a foundation for new real estate and economic development activity appropriate for a planned community along the Developing Tier Corridor of Pennsylvania Avenue, and at a possible future Center in the Westphalia area, as articulated in the 2002 Approved Prince George's County General Plan. The recommendations will promote quality planned community development, encourage quality economic development, preserve and protect environmentally sensitive and scenic land, and maximize public benefits through the provision of adequate public facilities.

WHEREAS, Sections 27-225.01.05 and 27-641 of the Zoning Ordinance establish procedures whereby the Prince George's County Planning Board may initiate a master plan amendment and a concurrent Sectional Map Amendment (SMA) with the approval of the District Council; and

WHEREAS, the approved FY 2006 Planning Department Work Program requires that a sector plan be prepared for the Westphalia area; and

WHEREAS, the sector plan area, being a part of Planning Area 78, is to be comprised of the properties located within the October 2005 *Westphalia Comprehensive Concept Plan* study area, generally east of the Capital Beltway, north of Pennsylvania Avenue (MD 4), west of

Ritchie Marlboro Road, and south of White House Road (See the October 2005 Westphalia Comprehensive Concept Plan study area boundary map); and

WHEREAS, the October 2005 Westphalia Comprehensive Concept Plan study provided a refinement and a detailed update to the vision, analysis, and information contained in the 1994 Approved Melwood-Westphalia Master Plan (Planning Area 77 & 78) as a means of facilitating the orderly and cohesive development of a planned community in the Westphalia area; and

WHEREAS, the October 2005 Westphalia Comprehensive Concept Plan study provides a description of goals, concepts and guidelines for future development of this area; and

WHEREAS, during preparation of the October 2005 Westphalia Comprehensive Concept Plan study a lengthy, substantive, and well-notified public participation process was conducted between June and August 2005 including a pre-charrette, multiple public charrettes, a final public presentation, a mailed community survey, and visual preference survey; and

WHEREAS, the goals of the sector plan are to guide orderly, cohesive, quality planned community development, to encourage quality economic development, to preserve and protect environmentally sensitive and scenic land, and to maximize public benefits through the provision of adequate public facilities in the Westphalia Sector Plan area; and

WHEREAS, the sector plan will set development policy and guidelines to provide a mix of uses at an intensity appropriate for a node along a Developing Tier Corridor, and will evaluate the designation of a possible future Center in the Westphalia area, as articulated in the 2002 *Approved Prince George's County General Plan*.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission is hereby directed to prepare a sector plan and a concurrent SMA for the Westphalia area in accordance with the requirements of Parts 3 and 13 of the Zoning Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that that the development vision and issues of the October 2005 *Westphalia Comprehensive Concept Plan* study shall constitute the goals, concepts and guidelines for preparation of the preliminary sector plan and SMA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the public involvement process conducted during preparation of the October 2005 *Westphalia Comprehensive Concept Plan* study shall constitute the public participation process for preparation of the preliminary sector plan and SMA, which will be followed by a duly advertised public hearing held according to Section 27-644(b) of the
