SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince

George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Sections 27-107.1(a) and 27-461(b) of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, be and the same are hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

DIVISION 1. DEFINITIONS.

Sec. 27-107.1. Definitions.

- (a) Terms in the Zoning Ordinance are defined as follows:
- (243) **Transit Stop, Major:** A rapid rail transit terminal "Building", or a public transit stop served by fifteen (15) or more transit vehicles travelling in one direction during a peak hour.
- freestanding residential facility owned and operated by an eleemosynary or philanthropic organization used for short-term living facilities for groups of two (2) or more homeless individuals related by blood, adoption or marriage, each occupying an individual residential unit. The term shall not include "Adult Day Care Center", "Congregate Living Facility", "Foster Home", "Group Residential Facility", "Hospital", "Nursing or Care Home", or "Eleemosynary or Philanthropic Institution".
