LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE REPORT

DATE: 5/1/90

Committee Vote: Favorable, 6-0 (In favor: Council Members Bell, Casula, Castaldi, Mills, Pemberton and Wilson)

The following economic modifications are contained in labor agreement:

- (1) 4% COL adjustment retroactive to July 1989
- (2) 5.14% COL adjustment for July 1, 1990
- (3) Shift differential for the midnight and evening shift are increased from \$1.70 to \$1.80 per hour and from \$1.30 to \$1.40 per hour effective January 1990
- (4) Clothing allowance paid to evidence technicians and public service aides is increased to \$500 per year
- (5) A modified salary rate to provide 3 1/2% increase in maximum rates for FY90 and FY91

The Office of Law has reviewed CR-36-1990 and find it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The fiscal impact on the County is negative in the amount of \$1,243,967 as a result of adopting CR-36 and CB-44. The breakdown of the amount is:

FY-90 \$369,462 FY-91 874,505 \$1,243,967

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT (Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

This is companion legislation to a Bill to approve the terms of the amended three year labor agreement between the County and the Police Civilian Employees Association for Fiscal Years 1990 - 1991. Salary Schedule P which applies to bargaining unit employees represented by the PCEA reflects the terms of that amended labor agreement.
