| SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, | |
| Maryland, that Section 23-138 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby | |
| repealed and reenacted with the following amendments: | |
| SUBTITLE 23. ROADS AND SIDEWALKS. | |
| DIVISION 3. DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS. | |
| Sec. 23-138. Standard paving sections. | |
| The Director of Public Works and Transportation shall establish minimum standards for | |
| paving sections for each class of roadway and incorporate such standards into the Design and | |
| Construction Standards. Where determined by the Director of Public Works and Transportation | |
| to be necessary by reason of engineering criteria, special designs may be allowed or required. | |

 [The Department of Public Works and Transportation shall submit to the County Council the list of roads to be repaved at least 60 days before contracts are approved. The County Council, by resolution, shall approve the list of roads to be repaved prior to the Department approving contracts.]

The Department of Public Works and Transportation shall submit to the County Council for review the list of roads to be repayed on an annual basis. The repaying list shall be prepared in December, and the Department shall present it to the County Council for general feedback.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
