RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Taxicab Service Task Force

For the purpose of establishing the Taxicab Service Task Force to review and evaluate the County's taxicab operations and their impact upon County residents, agencies and the industry and to recommend appropriate amendments to the County Code and regulations.

WHEREAS, Prince George's County established in 1974 a regulatory scheme to license and regulate the operations of taxi service in the County in order to provide efficient, safe and affordable transportation options for the residents of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Council last undertook a review and changes to the taxicab system in 2000 with the adoption of CB-49-2000; and

WHEREAS, the County Council has been approached by various stakeholders from the industry raising concerns about the operation and regulation of taxicab service in the County; and

WHEREAS, the County Council desires to further examine the operation of taxicab service and its impact on the residents and industry stakeholders and to consider appropriate recommendations for improvements related thereto; and

WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the Council may appoint, for designated periods, one or more temporary advisory boards of citizens of the County who shall assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Taxicab Service Task Force is hereby established to review and evaluate the County's taxicab operations and their impact upon County residents, agencies and the industry and to recommend appropriate amendments to the County Code and regulations.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Taxicab Service Task Force shall be composed of 7 2 members as follows: 3 1. The Chairperson of the County Council or the Chairperson's representative, who shall serve as the Chair of the Task Force; 4 5 The Director of the Department of Environmental Resources or the Director's 6 representative; 7 A representative from the County Police Department; 8 A member of the Prince George's Taxicab Board; 9 A representative of an owner or operator of a licensed taxicab company in the County; 5. A representative of the Prince George's County Taxi Workers Alliance; and 10 One (1) citizens of the County, with no pecuniary interest in any business related to the 11 12 industry, selected by the Chairperson of the County Council. 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Taxicab Service Task Force shall present its 14 evaluation and recommendations to the County Council on or before March 1, 2010. 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council Administrator shall assign appropriate technical and administrative support staff to assist the Taxicab Service Task Force in its work. 16 Adopted this 6^{th} day of October, 2009.
