10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, that Sections 2-451 and 2-457 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same
12 are hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

DIVISION 34. MINORITY BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES COMMISSION.

Sec. 2-451. Executive Director; administrative support.

16 There shall be an Executive Director of the Commission and such staff support and
17 facilities as may be authorized and provided [by appropriations] in the Office of Central
18 Services.

Sec. 2-457. Submission of budget.

20 The proposed budget of the Commission shall [prepare and submit] be submitted to the
21 County Executive [a proposed budget] as part of the budget of the Office of Central Services in

1 | accordance with County budget procedures.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
