**BILL**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Minority Business Opportunities Commission

3 For the purpose of amending the provisions of the Code regarding staffing and administration of  
4 the Minority Business Opportunities Commission.

5 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

6 SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.

7 Sections 2-451 and 2-457,

8 The Prince George's County Code

9 (1995 Edition, 1998 Supplement.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
11 Maryland, that Sections 2-451 and 2-457 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same  
12 are hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

13 **SUBTITLE 2. ADMINISTRATION.**

14 **DIVISION 34. MINORITY BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES COMMISSION.**

15 **Sec. 2-451. Executive Director; administrative support.**

16 There shall be an Executive Director of the Commission and such staff support and  
17 facilities as may be authorized and provided [by appropriations] in the Office of Central  
18 Services.

19 **Sec. 2-457. Submission of budget.**

20 The proposed budget of the Commission shall [prepare and submit] be submitted to the  
21 County Executive [a proposed budget] as part of the budget of the Office of Central Services in

1 accordance with County budget procedures.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
