REPORT: Favorable, 4-0 (In Favor: Council Members Glaros, Lehman, Taveras, and Turner. Absent: Harrison)

CR-74-2017 is legislation to declare certain parcels of County-owned real property as surplus to the County's needs and to propose disposition of said parcels. The Resolution is being submitted in accordance with Section 2-111.01 of the County Code.

During the Committee review of the proposed legislation, Floyd Holt, Deputy Director, Office of Central Services, provided a full explanation of the plans for the surplus property. Located in the Collington Center, the 73 acres will be used for a state of the art Lacrosse Stadium. Known as the Collington Athletic Complex this project has been in the Capital Improvement Budget since 2001. This project offers the opportunity for a unique public (State, Stadium Authority, and County) not for profit partnership in the design construction and operation of a state of the art sports complex.

The Office of Law reports CR-74-2017 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

After the project presentation and discussion, the Public Safety and Fiscal Management Committee voted CR-74-2017 out favorably 4-0.
