OR DISTRIBUTION OF CERTAIN CIGAR PRODUCTS for the purpose of amending the provisions of the County Code prohibiting the sale, offer or distribution of cigar and cigar products intended for or designed for the use in ingesting, inhaling or otherwise introducing marijuana, cocaine, hashish, or hashish oil into the human body to minor and in quantities fewer than packages of five. - PRESENTED
