WHEREAS	, the District Council adopted CR-60-2008 on June 17, 2008, initiating an	
amendment to the	e 1994 Approved Hyattsville and Vicinity Master Plan (Planning Area 68), the	
1994 Approved E	Bladensburg, New Carrollton and Vicinity Master Plan (Planning Area 69), the

Plan, to ensure t	hat future development is consistent with County policies; and	
WHEREAS	, the sector plan area being part of Planning Areas 68 and 69 is generally	
comprised of the	properties contained within the municipal boundaries of the Bladensburg,	
Colmar Manor, C	Cottage City and Edmonston as well as including properties south of the	
Bladensburg mur	nicipal boundary from the south side of Annapolis Road to the Baltimore	
Washington Park	tway (excluding the properties within the Cheverly municipal boundary) east to	
the Colmar Manor municipal boundary; and properties east of the Edmonston municipal		
boundary and no	rth and west of the Bladensburg boundary to Carters Lane; and	

WHEREAS, Section 27-645 of the Zoning Ordinance for Prince George's County, Maryland, requires the Prince George's Planning Board of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission to submit its proposals for public facilities in the Plan to the District Council and to the County Executive prior to adoption by the Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Ordinance also provides a review period for the County Executive and the District Council to review, provide written comments, and identify any inconsistencies between the public facilities proposed in the Plan and any existing or proposed State or County facilities including roads, highways, or other public facilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 27-645 provides that the adopted plan may not include a highway or transportation line unless the District Council, after consultation with the County Executive, approves (by resolution) the inclusion of the highway or transportation line for planning purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board referred the public facilities element of the Preliminary Sector Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment for the Port Towns Sector Plan for review, comments, and the identification of any inconsistencies between the public facilities proposed in the Plan and any existing or proposed State or County facilities on March 5, 2009, attached hereto as Attachment A; and

WHEREAS, upon review the District Council has concluded that, in general, the public facilities transportation proposals contained in the Preliminary Sector Plan are consistent with the county's Capital Improvement Program ("CIP") and the State's Consolidated Transportation Program ("CTP").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the transportation system and public facilities proposals in the public facilities element of the Preliminary Sector Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment for the Port Towns Sector Plan, as transmitted on March 5, 2009 by the Prince George's Planning Board of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, are hereby approved for inclusion in the Preliminary Plan.
