

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

The proposed legislation would define the misdemeanor crime of following or stalking another person with the express or implied threat of serious physical injury or death to that person. The legislation is modeled after legislation enacted in approximately 20 states. The Maryland General Assembly failed to enact similar legislation in the 1992 Session.
