RESOLUTION

The disposition of three parcels of unimproved County-owned

A RESOLUTION concerning

property known as South Laurel Senior High School Site,

Northhampton Junior High School Site, and Hutchison Elementary

School Site, as more fully described in Attachment "A"

FOR the purpose of approving the proposal of the County Executive
that the full extent of the Northampton Junior High School Site,
Hutchison Elementary School Site, and approximately twenty-five
acres of the South Laurel Senior High School Site should be
designated and disposed of to promote affordable family housing
and/or elderly housing purposes in accordance with the provisions of
Section 2-111.1 of the Prince George's County Code.

WHEREAS, Section 2-111.1 of the Prince George's County Code, as amended by CB-56-1989, requires that the County Executive shall submit to the County Council, for its approval by resolution, his proposal to sell and transfer the three properties for a specific

public purpose; and purposes including elderly housing and affordable family housing; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has submitted to the County Council his proposal that three parcels of unimproved County-owned property should each be sold for a nominal amount of One Dollar (\$1.00) to Prince George's Housing Authority to be used for the purposes of affordable family housing and/or elderly housing, in accordance with the specific purposes and objectives of the CHOICE Housing Initiative Program, namely the Northampton Junior High School and the Hutchison Elementary School sites for affordable family housing; and the South Laurel Senior High School site for elderly housing and affordable family housing; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the proposed plan of the County Executive to dispose of the three County-owned properties more fully described in Attachment "A", by sale for a nominal amount of One Dollar (\$1.00) each to the Prince George's Housing Authority in accordance with the provisions of Section 2-111.1 of the County Code, as amended by CB-56-1989, for the purpose of promoting affordable family housing and/or elderly housing is hereby approved.
