RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

The Public Facilities Element of the Preliminary Plan Prince George's 2035

For the purpose of identifying inconsistencies between the Preliminary *Plan Prince George's*2035 and existing or proposed State or County facilities, and approving the inclusion of any new transportation proposals prior to adoption of the preliminary plan by the Planning Board.

WHEREAS, Section 27-645(b)(1) of the Zoning Ordinance for Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, requires the Prince George's County Planning Board to submit its proposal for public facilities in the preliminary sector plan to the County Executive and the District Council for identification of any inconsistencies between the public facilities recommendations and existing or proposed State or County public facilities, including roads; and, in the event of any inconsistencies, the District Council shall direct the Planning Board on how the inconsistencies shall be eliminated or accommodated within the plan; and

WHEREAS, Section 27-645 also requires the Planning Board to submit its proposals for public facilities in the preliminary plan to the District Council and the County Executive prior to its adoption of the Plan; and

WHEREAS, Section 27-645 further provides that the adopted plan may not include a highway or transportation line unless the District Council approves by resolution, after consultation with the County Executive, the inclusion of the highway or transportation line for planning purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Ordinance also provides a 60-day review period for the County Executive and the District Council to consider the preliminary recommendations, provide written comments, and identify any inconsistencies between the public facilities proposed in the plan and any existing or proposed State or County facilities including roads, highways, or other public facilities; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 2013, the District Council adopted CR-3-2013, initiating preparation of a new general Plan for the entire county to provide policy direction, identify development priorities, and broad strategies for future community plans, functional plans, and implementation programs; and

WHEREAS, the general plan is for the entire jurisdiction of Prince George's County, excluding the City of Laurel; and

WHEREAS, in adopting CR-3-2013 on May 15, 2012, the District Council authorized initiation of a Sector Plan for the Eastover / Forest Heights / Glassmanor and concurrent Sectional Map Amendment and approved the Goals, Concepts, Guidelines and a Public Participation Program in order to develop a comprehensive approach to implement the recommendations of the 2002 General Plan, to ensure that future development is consistent with County policies; and

WHEREAS, the sector plan area generally includes the land area of Prince George's County bounded to the south by the Capital Beltway, to the west at the District of Columbia Line / Southern Avenue, and includes properties along Livingston Road to the Northeast, in Planning Area 76A; and

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2013, the Planning Board referred the public facilities recommendations in the Preliminary Sector Plan and Proposed Sectional Map Amendment for review, comments, and the identification of any inconsistencies between the public facilities proposed in the Plan and any existing or proposed State or County facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the County Executive, by letter dated September 10, 2013, to the Chairman of the Planning Board expressed general support for the public facilities recommendations contained within the preliminary plan;

WHEREAS, Section 27-645(b)(1) of the Zoning Ordinance for Prince George's County, Maryland, requires the Prince George's Planning Board of The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission to submit its proposals for public facilities in the plan to the District

Council and to the County Executive prior to adoption by the Planning Board; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Ordinance also provides a review period for the County Executive and the District Council to review, provide written comments, and identify any inconsistencies between the public facilities proposed in the plan and any existing or proposed State or County facilities including roads, highways, or other public facilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 27-645(b)(1) provides that the adopted plan may not include a highway or transportation line unless the District Council, after consultation with the County Executive, approves (by resolution) the inclusion of the highway or transportation line for planning purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board referred the public facilities element of the Preliminary General Plan for review, comments, and the identification of any inconsistencies between the public facilities proposed in the plan and any existing or proposed State or County facilities on November 21, 2013, attached hereto as Attachment A; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated February 5, 2014, the County Executive found no inconsistencies between the County's inconsistencies between the County's Capital Improvement Capital Improvement Program ("CIP") and the State's Consolidated Transportation Program ("CTP") and the preliminary *Plan Prince George's* 2035; and

WHEREAS, on February 18, 2014, the District Council reviewed the public facilities transportation proposals contained in the Preliminary Plan Prince George's 2035, considered correspondence from the Office of the County Executive dated February 5, 2014, and concluded that no inconsistencies exist between the County's Capital Improvement Program ("CIP") and the State's Consolidated Transportation Program ("CTP") and the preliminary *Plan Prince George's* 2035.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the inclusion of any new transportation proposals in the public facilities element of the preliminary *Plan Prince George's* 2035 transmitted by the Prince George's County Planning Board on December 12, 2013, set forth in Attachment A and incorporated as if set forth fully herein, be and the same are hereby approved for inclusion in the preliminary plan by the Planning Board.
