In FY'90 Association for Retarded Citizens (ARC) expanded the Medical Day Care Program to serve a large number of medically frail developmentally disabled County residents. This grant increase is necessary because of the difficulties ARC experienced in implementing the program expansion. Enrollment of additional clients in the program was delayed in order to address the transportation requirements of retrofitting the vans to transport clients.

The grant increase in the amount of \$40,000 expresses the County's continuing commitment to this vital program and in recognition of its contribution to the quality of life of the handicapped citizens it

serves.

The Director of Finance has certified in writing that the funds in the amount of \$40,000 is available from the fund balance for the supplementary appropriation.

The Office of Law has reviewed this legislation and find it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CB-40 will be negative in the amount of \$40,000.
