This emergency bill is for the disposition of a parcel located at the Collington Center (4th Councilmanic District). The emergency is the result of a sales contract with a tentative date of settlement around the end of September. The current assessed value for the 10.61 acres is \$676,050. The purchase price for the property is \$878,292.

The fiscal impact on the County will be positive in the amount of the purchase price plus any applicable transfer and recordation taxes.
