Committee Vote: Favorable, 4-0 (In favor: Council Members Patterson, Campos, Olson, and Toles)

Staff summarized the purpose of the legislation and informed the committee of referral comments that were received. CB-35-2011 was transmitted by the Planning Board for the County Council's consideration. This legislation amends the Zoning Ordinance to clarify the definition for Master Plan and Sector Plan. In addition, CB-35-2011 amends the Sectional Map Amendment procedures by adding the words "Sector Plan" to all regulations that are applicable to a Master Plan.

The Office of Law reviewed CB-35-2011 and determined that it is in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment. The Department of Environmental Resources takes no position on this legislation.
