**BILL**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of adding a class title and grade for a certain class of work.

4 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County  
 5 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has, in order  
 6 to provide better governmental services, recommended to the County Council an amendment to  
 7 the Classification Plan for Prince George's County which would add a certain class of work  
 8 described within Section 1 of this Bill; now therefore,

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
 10 Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County be and the same is hereby  
 11 amended as follows:

12 3403P Emergency Dispatcher IV, P-21

13 (\$36,224 - \$66,992)

14 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)  
 15 calendar days after it becomes law.
