## BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

Currently, roadside vendors are permitted to sell a number of items in the public right-of-way, including flowers, vegetables, meat and seafood. This legislation will prohibit all sales in a public right-of-way, with the exception of automotive equipment to a disabled vehicle, and ice cream vendors, provided they are not parked for more than ten minutes. This prohibition on roadside vendors is similar to the laws in Montgomery, Baltimore, and Anne Arundel Counties.
