WHEREAS	s, the Paint Branch Montessori School, formerly located in the Paint Branch
Unitarian Univer	salist Church in Adelphi, provides elementary education to approximately 70
children; and	
WHEREAS	s, on December 9, 2003, a fire at the Paint Branch Unitarian Universalist Church
damaged or destr	royed portions of the Church structure where the School was located:
WHEREAS	s, reconstruction and repair of the damaged and destroyed portions of the Church
structure has not	been completed and will take several additional months to complete; and
WHEREAS	s, pursuant to the adoption of CR-4-2004, the District Council approved the
temporary reloca	tion of the Paint Branch Montessori School to the Lutheran Church of Abiding
Presence, 11310	Montgomery Road in Beltsville for a period not to exceed six months; and
WHEREAS	s, it is the desire of the District Council to extend the temporary suspension of
the requirements	of the Zoning Ordinance previously granted through the adoption of CR-4-2004
on January 17, 20	004 to allow the Paint Branch Montessori School to continue its relocation to the
Lutheran Church	of Abiding Presence, 11310 Montgomery Road in Beltsville for an additional
nariod of time no	at to extend beyond November 30, 2004

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's

1 County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington 2 Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that, notwithstanding the requirement of 3 the Zoning Ordinance to the contrary, a private school may be located in an existing structure without first obtaining a special exception for the use and without regard to requirements that 4 5 may arise from the operation of a private school relating to the exterior of the existing structure 6 such as parking and loading, landscaping, screening, buffering, signage, and other specific 7 requirements of the Zoning Ordinance that would require the alteration of the exterior of the 8 existing structure or parcel, subject to the requirements specified in CR-4-2004 until 9 November 30, 2004.
