RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Acting Director of Homeland Security

3 For the purpose of extending the appointment of Vernon R. Herron as Acting Director of
4 Homeland Security.

5 WHEREAS, Section 505 of the Charter of Prince George's County, Maryland, provides for
6 the County Executive to make a sixty-day temporary appointment to the position of head of any
7 agency of the Executive Branch if such position shall become vacant; and

8 WHEREAS, Section 505 further provides that such appointment may be extended an
9 additional four calendar months by resolution of the County Council; and

10 WHEREAS, by Executive Order No. 36-2003, Vernon R. Herron was appointed as Acting
11 Director of Homeland Security, effective November 3, 2003; and

12 WHEREAS, the search for a permanent director is underway; and

13 WHEREAS, the County Council will be in recess when the above-referenced Executive
14 Order expires;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
16 County, Maryland, that the appointment of Vernon R. Herron as Acting Director of Homeland
17 Security be and the same is hereby extended for a period of up to four calendar months, effective
18 upon the expiration of the sixty-day period set forth in Executive Order No. 36-2003.
