BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

The proposed legislation repeals certain provisions of the County Code pertaining to the operation of public schools. These provisions were first enacted in 1924 and were last amended by the General Assembly in 1963. The subject matter covered by these County Code provisions is comprehensively covered by the Education Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland which was first enacted in 1978.
