Dear Chair Ivey:

Enclosed for the County Council's consideration is a Bill required pursuant to State law which requires the County to impose either a sales tax of at least five percent (5%) on telecommunications or a \$3.50 per month per line excise tax on telecommunications.

A sales tax of eight percent (8%) on telecommunications has been in effect since FY 2003 and was increased to nine percent (9%) in 2015. While the revenue from the sales tax originally approximated \$50 million a year for several years, changes in technology and communication trends caused the revenue to erode. Use of texting and emails, Internet-based calling and other changes were not anticipated by the original legislation. By FY 2024 the revenue had decreased to \$13.5 million. This legislation will enact an excise tax, similar to Montgomery County and Baltimore City, which provides a more stable level of annual revenue like the 9-1-1 surcharge. All revenue will continue to be dedicated to the County's share of K-12 education funding.
