BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Video Lottery Facility Funding

3 For the purpose of amending the definition of “public education purposes” to include grants to
4 non-profits that provide education services.

5 BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

6 SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

7 Section 10-309.01,

8 The Prince George's County Code

9 (2019 Edition; 2021 Supplement).

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11 Maryland, that Section 10-309.01 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
12 repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

13 SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

14 DIVISION 22. VIDEO LOTTERY FACILITY LOCAL BUSINESS, HIRING, AND
15 FUNDING REQUIREMENTS.

16 **Sec. 10-309.01. Video Lottery Facility Funding.**

17 (a) Fifty percent (50%) of Annual Local Gaming Revenue, up to a maximum of \$25
18 million, shall be allocated for [public] education purposes by the County in its regular
19 or supplemental budget processes.

20 (1) “[Public e] Education purposes” in this Section means operating or capital budget

1 spending for the Prince George’s County Public Schools (including pre-kindergarten
2 through 12th grade), Prince George’s County Public Schools (including pre-
3 kindergarten through 12th grade), Prince George’s Community College, and Prince
4 George’s County Memorial Library System, and grant funds to non-profit
5 organizations that provide educational services.

7 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
8 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
9 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
10 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining
11 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
12 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such
13 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
14 or section.

15 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on forty-five (45)
16 calendar days after it becomes law.
