BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Supplementary Appropriations

3 For the purpose of appropriating additional revenue from available and uncommitted fund
4 balances to the Drug Enforcement and Education Special Revenue Fund, and to provide funds
5 for costs that were not anticipated in the Approved Fiscal Year 1998-1999 Budget for the Drug
6 Enforcement and Education Special Revenue Fund.

7 WHEREAS, CB-54-1998, as amended, adopted and enacted the annual Budget and
8 Appropriation Ordinance of Prince George=s County for FY1998-1999, which sets forth the
9 amount of appropriations and revenue estimates, said appropriation and revenue estimates to be
10 adjusted as hereinafter set forth; and

11 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George=s County, Maryland,
12 the County Council may, upon recommendation of the County Executive, make additional or
13 supplementary appropriations from revenue received from anticipated sources but in excess of
14 budget estimates therefor, from revenue received from sources not anticipated in the budget for
15 the current year, and from prior year available and uncommitted fund balances, provided that the
16 Director of Finance shall first certify in writing that such funds are available for such
17 appropriation; and

18 WHEREAS, certain funds of the County government require additional appropriations as
19 provided herein, and certain additional revenues have been identified; and

20 WHEREAS, the County Executive has duly recommended that the supplementary
21 appropriations be made; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has certified in writing that fund balance is available for such supplementary appropriations; now therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the following adjustments to revenue estimates for Fiscal Year 1998-1999 for Other Funds as expressed in CB-54-1998, as amended, are made:
