RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Formation of an Agricultural District pursuant to the
3 Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation Program

4 For the purpose of recommending that the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation
5 approves the petition of Thomas Maslin and Cheryl Swing to establish an agricultural district.

6 WHEREAS, a district agreement, dated on November 17, 2006, by Thomas Maslin and
7 Cheryl Swing requested the establishment of an agricultural preservation district for
8 approximately 23.12 acres of land (Map 148, Parcel 22) located on the southern side of Tanyard
9 Road in the Upper Marlboro area, as generally shown on the attached location map; and

10 WHEREAS, the petition was referred to the Prince George’s County Agricultural
11 Preservation Advisory Board and the Prince George’s County Planning Board for review and
12 recommendation; and

13 WHEREAS, the Prince George’s County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board found
14 that the Thomas Maslin and Cheryl Swing property met the qualifying criteria for productivity,
15 size, and location as set by the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation, and
16 recommended establishment of the agricultural district on November 29, 2006; and

17 WHEREAS, the Prince George’s County Planning Board found that the establishment of
18 the proposed agricultural district is compatible with existing and approved county plans and
19 recommended approval of the petition and establishment of the district on December 21, 2006.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
21 County, Maryland, that Parcel 22 described in the agricultural district petition filed by Thomas
22 Maslin and Cheryl Swing is recommended to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation

1 Foundation for approval.

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution, copies of the petition, maps, and copies
3 of the letters from the Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board and the Prince George’s County
4 Planning Board, be forwarded by the Clerk of the Council to the County Executive for his
5 consideration and, upon his approval, transmittal to the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation
6 Foundation for appropriate action.
