LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

Date: 10/20/92

Committee Vote: Favorable, as amended, 6-0 (In Favor: Council Members Castaldi, Casula, Del Giudice, Fletcher, MacKinnon and Wineland)

Ann Landry Lombardi, chairperson of the "Ethics in the Workplace Study Panel" supports the adoption of this legislation.

The amendments to this legislation are:

- (1) On page 3, lines 9-10, delete "County Executive" and insert "Board".
- (2) On page 3, line 10, delete "designate" and insert "elect".
- (3) On page 3, line 27, after "Ethics." insert the following:
"If, in the judgment of the Chairman, the lack of attendance of any

member of the Board is impeding the work of the Board, the Chairman shall notify the County Executive and the County Council."

- (4) On page 9, line 2, delete the period after "Act" and insert ", provided that an amendment to Section 1001 of the Charter has been adopted by the voters of the County."

There should not be any negative impact on the County as a result of adopting CB-99-1992.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT

This bill will define and place certain restrictions on the receipt of honoraria; amending the provisions relating to the membership, terms, quorum and meeting requirements, and duties of the Board of Ethics. Also, the legislation will amend the provisions relating to certain prohibited conduct.
