RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Formation of an Agricultural District pursuant to the
3 Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation Program

4 For the purpose of recommending that the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation
5 approves the petition of Arthur and Roswitha Leitch to establish an agricultural district.

6 WHEREAS, a district agreement, dated on July 27, 2007, by Arthur and Roswitha Leitch
7 requested the establishment of an agricultural preservation district for approximately 64.83 acres
8 of land (Tax Map 174/Grid F1/Parcel 35/Tax Account 08-0832147 and 08-0832154) located at
9 17220 Aquasco Farm Road in the Aquasco area in Prince George’s County, Maryland, as
10 generally shown on the attached location map; and

11 WHEREAS, the petition was referred to the Prince George’s County Agricultural
12 Preservation Advisory Board for review and recommendation; and

13 WHEREAS, the Prince George’s County Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board found
14 that the Arthur and Roswitha Leitch property met the qualifying criteria for productivity, size
15 and location as set by the Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation, and
16 recommended establishment of the agricultural district on August 29, 2007; and

17 WHEREAS, the Prince George’s County Planning Board found that the establishment of
18 the proposed agricultural district is compatible with existing and approved county plans and
19 recommended approval of the petition and establishment of the district on October 23, 2007; and

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
21 County, Maryland, that the land indentified as Tax Map 174/Grid F4Parcel 35/Tax Account 08-
22 0832147 and 08-0832154described in the agricultural district petition filed by Arthur and

1 Roswitha Leitch is recommended to the Maryland Agricultural land Preservation Foundation for
2 approval.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution, copies of the petition, maps and copies
4 of the letters from the Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board and the Prince George’s County
5 Planning Board, be forwarded by the Clerk of the Council to the County Executive for his
6 consideration and, upon approval, transmittal to the Maryland Agricultural land Preservation
7 Foundation for appropriate action.
