CB-23-2004 – AN ACT CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF SPECIAL **OBLIGATION BONDS** for the purpose of providing that special obligation bonds may be issued from time to time under the provisions of this Act, in an amount not to exceed the aggregate principal amount of Sixty-five Million Dollars (\$65,000,000) in order for the County to finance the construction of the public infrastructure improvements; making certain findings and determinations concerning the public benefit and purpose of such special obligation bonds; providing that such special obligation bonds shall be payable from the amounts levied and deposited in the Tax Increment Fund, including certain County hotel occupancy taxes and other tax revenues and from the special tax to be levied and deposited in the Special Taxing District Fund and that the special obligation bonds shall not constitute a general obligation debt of the County or a pledge of the County's full faith and credit or taxing power other than the taxes representing the levy on the Tax Increment, the Hotel Tax, the National Harbor Convention Center Excess Development District Taxes and the Special tax; authorizing the County Executive to take certain actions, to execute the documents and make certain commitments on behalf of the County in connection with the issuance, sale and delivery of such special obligation bonds; and generally providing for, and determining various matters in connection with the issuance, sale, delivery and payment of such special obligation bonds.

CB-24-2004 – AN ACT CONCERNING ISSUANCE AND SALE OF SPECIAL

OBLIGATION BONDS for the purpose of providing that special obligation bonds may be issued from time to time under the provisions of this Act, in an amount not to exceed the aggregate principal amount of Ninety-five Million Dollars (\$95,000,000) for the County finance a portion of the costs of the convention center; making certain findings and determinations, among others, concerning the public benefit and purpose of such special obligation bonds; providing that such special obligations bonds authorized to be issued hereby shall be payable from the amounts levied and deposited in the Tax Increment Fund, including the Hotel Tax and from the Special Hotel Rental Tax to be levied and deposited in the Special Taxing District Fund and that the special obligation bonds shall not constitute a general obligation debt of the County or a pledge of the County's full faith and credit or taxing power other than the Tax Increment, the Hotel Tax and the Special Hotel Rental Tax; authorizing the County Executive of the County to specify, prescribe, determine, provide for and approve certain details, forms, documents or procedures in connection with such special obligation bonds; and generally providing for, and determining various matters in connection with, the issuance, sale, delivery and payment of such special obligation bonds.
