For the purpose of increasing the additional fee on marriage licenses to finance Battered Spouse		
Shelters and Dor	nestic Violence programs in the County.	
WHEREAS, Section 2-404 (n) Family Law, Article, Annotated Code of Maryland (2006		
Replacement Vo	lume) provides that the County Council may set by resolution an additional	
marriage license fee of up to sixty dollars (\$60.00) for each license, the proceeds of which shall		
be used to fund battered spouse shelters and domestic violence programs; and		
WHEREAS, the additional fee for marriage licenses in Prince George's County is currently		
forty-five dollars (\$45.00) as established by CR-38-1993.		
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's		
County, Maryland, that the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County, Maryland is		
hereby directed, pursuant to the provisions of Section 2-404 (n) of the Family Law Article to		
collect an additional fee of sixty dollars (\$60.00) on each marriage license issued after the		
adoption of this l	Resolution.	
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proceeds of such additional fee are to be remitted		
to the Director of Finance to finance battered spouse shelters and domestic violence programs as		
set forth in the County budget and appropriation process.		
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded by the		
Clerk of the Council to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County, the Director of		
Finance and the	County Executive.
