A RESOLUTION concerning

Salary Rate Changes

For the purpose of establishing the effective date of salary rate adjustments.

WHEREAS, Section 16-143(D) of the Prince George's County Code provides that salary rate changes may not be retroactive unless authorized by law; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance is required to keep a system of accounts, control appropriations and allotments, and prescribe accounting systems; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance should determine the most effective and efficient manner in which to process the payroll system and, in particular, the method of paying salary rate adjustments; and

WHEREAS, the establishment and implementation of the new Cyborg On-line Human Resource software system provides an effective and efficient method of processing salary rate adjustments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that all salary rate adjustments may be effective as of the first day of the pay period in which the adjustment occurs.
