COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

The Committee of the Whole convened on May 13, 2014, to consider CB-32-2014. After orientation by the Office of the County Executive and cabinet members on the legislation, which relates to a reorganizational proposal forwarded by the County Executive, the Committee voted 9-0 for a favorable recommendation on CB-32-2014 as amended.

This legislation is companion legislation to the reorganization proposal included in Executive Order No. 10-2014 and will amend Subtitle 27 of the County Code such that references to the Department of Environmental Resources be changed to the Department of the Environment. This name change will more accurately reflect the functions of the department to distinguish it from its past identity as a building permit, inspection and code enforcement agency with a renewed image that projects responsible and innovative environmental stewardship.
